# CAMP AT A GLANCE



Camp Aranzazu (pronounced Ah ran' zah zoo) is dedicated to enriching the lives of children and adults with chronic illnesses and special needs by providing unique camping, environmental education and retreat experiences. The name "Aranzazu" is a Basque term that means "a spiritual place requiring a difficult path to reach."

Located on 104 acres near Rockport, Texas, Camp Aranzazu sits on property that was previously an Episcopal Church retreat. Tom and Holly Forney, inspired by the beauty of the location, purchased the property with the vision of serving others while protecting this historically and ecologically rich land in the Coastal Bend area. This unique campus has 27 acres of waterfront and wetlands on the Copano Bay.

Camp Aranzazu was established as a non-profit, 501(c)(3) organization in 2002. The first campers attended in June 2006. The camp was accredited by the American Camp Association in 2007. Since that time, more than 22,000 campers and their support staff have enjoyed time at Camp Aranzazu.

This incomparable facility offers a memorable experience to campers who have different challenges. These include epilepsy, muscular dystrophy, Down syndrome, autism, cancer, spina bifida, asthma, cerebral palsy, juvenile diabetes, kidney disease, adolescent obesity, head and spinal cord injuries, neurological differences, hearing and sight impairments, just to name a few.
